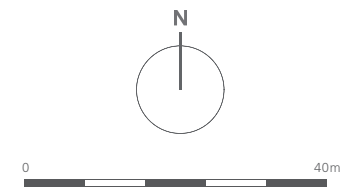

  - Trees to have crown removed but trunk retained as a standing pole for habitat value
  - Hedges
  - Cattle shed to be retained in its current state

- Trees
  - Native hedges
  - Native planting
  - Decorative planting
  - Mown grass
  - Meadow grass with bulbs
  - Footpath (2m wide, bound gravel)
  - Seating area with trough/pool to collect field / spring water
  - Maintenance area (compost / rubbish and tap for flowers)
  - Vehicular and pedestrian access gates
  - Car park
  - Benches
  - Fencing – post and rail



**NOTES**

Cattle Shed

In accordance with the findings of the 'Ecological Appraisal' (C\_EDP1736\_03a) the cattle shed to be retained in its current state as a bat roosting site with public access prohibited to prevent disturbance and for health and safety reasons.

Should future proposals require that the building is to be affected by demolition or restoration works, or similar, such works would need to be completed under a Natural England EPS mitigation licence, the completion of which would require a greater roost survey effort in order to characterise the roost type present.

Trees

All tree work to be in accordance with the 'Findings of Arboricultural Assessment' (T\_EDP1736\_02b). All trees to be retained to be protected in accordance with this report.

In accordance with the 'Ecological Appraisal' (C\_EDP1736\_03a) prior to tree surgery works a thorough tree assessment for the likelihood to support roosting bats (including aerial tree surveys where necessary) should be completed. Tree works that would result in the loss of a confirmed bat roost would require an EPS mitigation licence.

Bat boxes to be located in mature trees by a qualified ecologist.
